RE: Remote Learning Provision Reception to Year 6 January 2021

As Redbridge Primary will be closed until the 18th January, except for those children whose parents are key workers, we have outlined below the remote learning provision for the next two weeks. We have made some amendments to our previous offer.

Our remote learning provision will be comprised of a combination of pre-recorded instructional videos, live online sessions hosted by the teacher and activities set for children to complete independently which can be submitted to the class teacher for feedback. In addition to this, Mr Davies will be recording daily stories for the children.

Google classroom will be the platform that the school uses with each class having its own 'classroom' set up. Class teachers will also have a dedicated email account linked to their own school account which families in their class will have access to.


Although live sessions may be led differently by class teachers, it is expected that year group teams work together to plan the remote learning so that all children in the year group receive the same set work to complete. This is because some teachers from each year group team will need to be in school teaching the Key Worker groups. However, all the children will have access to the same learning. The learning programme will be exactly the same whether it is remotely delivered or in school.

In the event that class teachers are unable to deliver their live sessions, arrangements have been made with the other year group teachers to ensure that these sessions are led by another member of the team.

We have included a brief outline of what the remote learning will look below. Children may submit any questions or queries they may have on the 'Stream' feature on Google Classroom for the teacher to answer. Children are able to 'turn in' their work via Google Classroom for the teacher to feedback on or alternatively they can complete their work in the exercise book that has been provided previously.

We understand and appreciate that every family has different extenuating circumstances that mean that not all children will be able to access the live sessions at the set time, we have tried where possible to stagger the year groups live sessions slightly to help with this. The timing and the link will be included on the class page on Google Classroom. Families may decide in the case of siblings, for the children to take it in turns to ensure all children in the family get an equal opportunity to participate in the live sessions.

The DFE has allocated the school a small number of laptops that can be used **on loan** by children to access the remote learning at home. There is set criteria that the school needs to follow in order to loan these devices. These were allocated to the school for the use by children who are entitled to Free School Meals and in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant to schools. Unfortunately, we are not able to allocate laptops as a secondary device on the basis that there are a number of siblings in the family who all need to use the same device. If your child has **no access** to a laptop/electronic device at home – ie the family does not own a computer, then please email the admin email address and if there are any spare laptops following the allocation then these may be loaned. Please note that Google Classroom can be used on any device such as a phone, Kindle or tablet.



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Although the remote learning is compulsory for schools to offer, it is not compulsory necessarily for the children to complete. Each family has their own needs and circumstances at the moment, such as parents working from home. So whilst we actively encourage children to complete the work online, there will be no repercussions if a child is unable to complete the work. All children will be supported to catch up on any missed learning once they return to school.
